


Wagging Rights

Have you taken the Standard Schnauzer Health Survey of 2008?

From the SSCA Website:

"The health of our Standard Schnauzers is important to all of us who have the opportunity to own these wonderful dogs, the dog sitting in our chair, lying on our couch or sleeping on our bed is important to the future of our breed. To obtain an accurate picture of the health of the breed, we need information on all dogs, not just dogs showing in conformation, participating in performance events or existing in breeding programs.

Having a picture of the health of our breed helps to: (1) dispel rumors of diseases that are not issues for our breed; (2) identify potential genetic diseases before they are widely distributed in our gene pool; (3) if necessary, focus our attention to development of diagnostic DNA tests. Standard Schnauzer folks have already established a fund with the Canine Health Foundation to support research into diseases affecting our breed. It is essential to have data for a large number of dogs and it is as important to have data on healthy dogs as it is dogs with health problems."

If you haven't already done so, please take a few minutes to complete the survey located on the SSCA website. There is still time to participate in this very important survey. The survey forms may be downloaded in either Word or rich text, completed electronically, and submitted via email or printed and completed as a paper copy (pdf-form).
