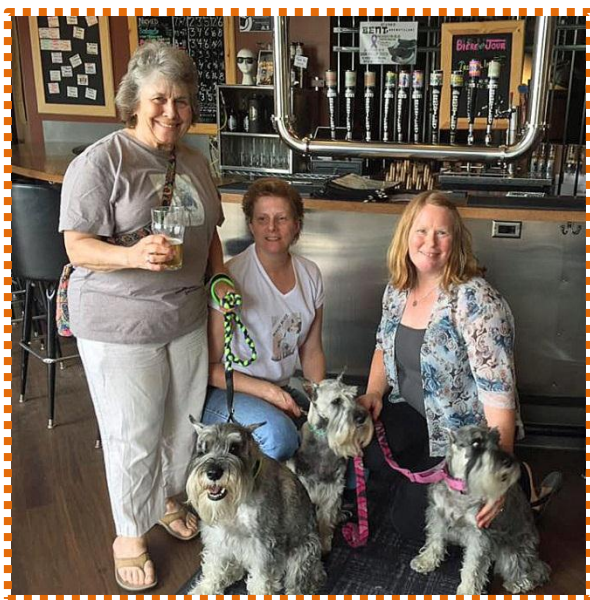

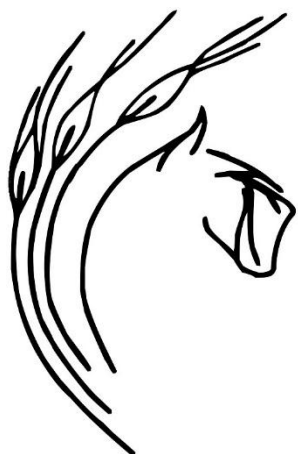
*"Thursday **Sully** was Best of Breed and Bria Best of Opposite in Duluth at the DECC.*

'Bone' Appetit

"Apple Crunch Pupcakes"

Ingredients:

- 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ cups water
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup applesauce (unsweetened)
- 2 tbsp honey
- $\frac{1}{8}$ tbsp vanilla extract
- 1 medium egg
- 4 cups whole wheat flour
- 1 cup dried apple chips (unsweetened)
- 1 tbsp baking powder

Directions:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees
2. Mix water, applesauce, honey, egg, and vanilla together in a bowl
3. Add remaining ingredients and mix until well blended
4. Pour into lightly greased muffin pans
5. Bake 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ hours
