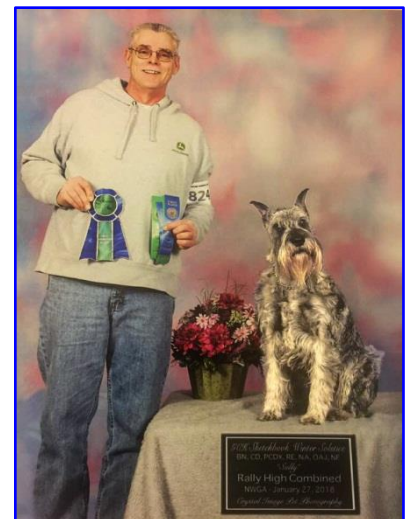

'Bone' Appetit

"CHESSY BONE TREATS"

Ingredients:

4 cups of flour
2 cups of shredded cheddar cheese
2 tbsp-1/4 cup of oil
1 1/3 cups of water

Directions:

Combine flour and cheese. Stir in oil and water. Adjust liquid as necessary to make stiff dough. Roll on floured cutting board to 3/8" thick. Cut with bone shaped cutter. Place on an ungreased cookie sheet. Bake for 2 1/2 – 3 hours in 250 degrees oven until thoroughly dry.

Optional Ingredient: 1 egg or use whole dried egg (powder)
